Golf is a wonderful game! You can play your whole life. All generations can play together. Golf is the only game with no referee. You call penalties on yourself. Thus, qualities such as honesty, integrity are essential to the game.

Golf Etiquette for Juniors

Learning how to act on the golf course should be the first lesson a child learns, even before learning how to hold the club. The sportsmanship, courtesy and integrity that the junior golfer learns are lifelong skills that they can use both on and off the course.

Definition

Etiquette might be a big word for the youngest of junior golfers, but the meaning is simple: acting properly and respecting your playing partners and the golf course.

FUNDAMENTAL RULE OF GOLF: play the ball as it lies and leave the course in better condition than you found it.

When playing golf at Madden's on Gull Lake I will...

1. Understand that it is a privilege that can be revoked at anytime
2. Respect the course, other golfers, staff, and the game
3. Use sportsman like conduct at all times
4. Wear appropriate golf attire which means: collared shirt, golf pants or shorts, hat on forwards
5. Refrain from inappropriate language and horseplay
6. Follow the rules and etiquette of the game to the best of your ability
7. Play on pace not more than 2 hours per 9-holes and directly behind the group in front of me.
